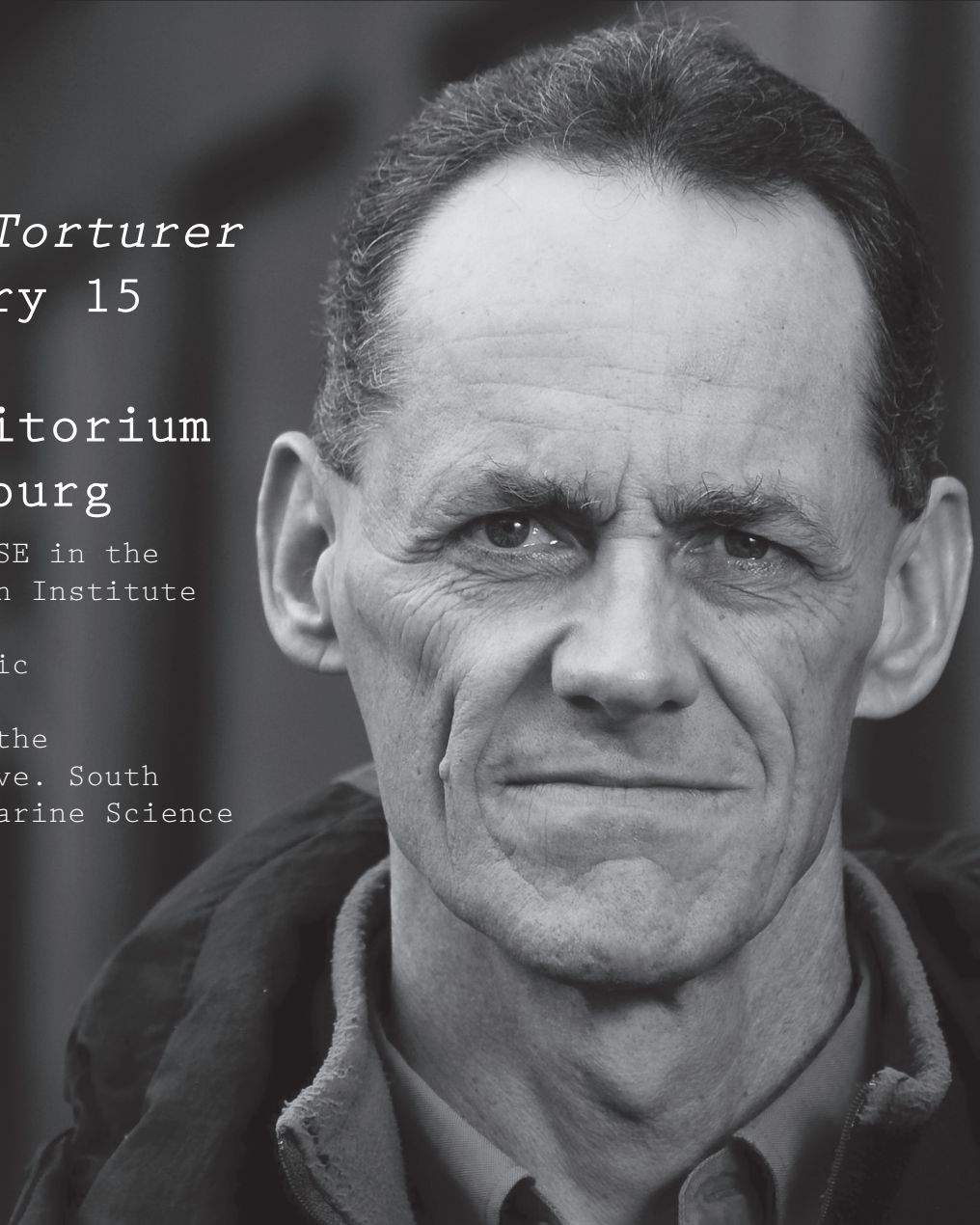

John Conroy, a widely respected print and broadcast journalist, is author of the acclaimed *Unspeakable Acts*, *Ordinary People*, a compelling examination of torture in Western societies. Some years earlier he wrote *Belfast Diary*, which the *New Statesman* deemed “the best book to date on Northern Ireland.” He recently finished his first play *Our Kind of Town*, an exploration of torture by the Chicago Police Department. It recently debuted in Chicago’s famed Steppenwolf Theater to high praise from the *New York Times*.
